The staff of Ballinure School aim to promote and award good behaviour in line with our Code of Behaviour and Positive School environment .

We aim to do this through these steps.

- Review and amend our code of behaviour /antibullying policy.
- Make Code of Behaviour available to Parents .
- Code of Behaviour to be discussed,explained in class rules are there for safety reasons and to protect the rights of others.
- Our School code of Behaviour is to be displayed in each classroom and on school noticeboard.
- Class rules to be drawn up in each classroom and to be displayed .
- Whole School assembly to be held every Monday morning ,prayers said together, a theme chosen for each month and highlighted at assembly and in class eg. Golden rule ,safety, teamwork, bullying .
- A positive School environment where everyone is treated with respect.
- Behaviour record cards are kept in class by teachers where repeated instances of misbehaviour are noted ,this record is relevant at parent/teacher meetings,behaviour concerns etc.Positive comments are also recorded and improvement noted.
- Parent/Teacher meeting held annually ,parents are always welcome to make an appointment to meet class teacher /principal.
- Yard area is zoned to ensure pupils play within their own class/age group.
- Praise and rewards are used as a means of promoting positive behaviour .
- .Assembly used to highlight areas in which we can grow as a school in terms of friendship, learning and personal growth .
- Sanctions for bisbehaviours- time out area,loss of privileges.
- Bucketfilling as a philosophy in senior room
- Something Wonderful award in junior room.
- Pupils encouraged and given responsibility within the school setting,eg ringing of bell, litter picking, leader in line, class cuiditheoir , playground pal,
- Older pupils encouraged to take on leadership role and give good example.
