

Learning Tables at Home..

- **TABLES ARE THE BUILDING BLOCKS FOR FUTURE MATHS .**
- Quick recall of tables will help your child complete his/her work Multiplication squares and calculator will help to speed up the process.
- Work on tables at home .
- Count on in 2's, 3's etc – depending on homework
- Write out the tables
- Work on doubles $6 \times 4 = 24$ so $12 \times 4 = 48$
- Know the rule for x by 10, 100
- Ask your child random tables
- Play dice game – roll dice x the numbers eg $6 \times 3 =$
- Spend a few minutes playing times tables game on maths websites.
- Race to 100 game – roll the dice eg 5 roll again 4,
- Make 54 continue to add on the numbers you make race to 100, 200, 1000 see who gets past the winning post first, Closest to target number wins.
- Oxford owl site has fun maths games for kids and times tables practise
